3. Be sure your child gets plenty of sleep the night before the test; students need at least 8 hours of sleep.
4. Be sure your child has a healthy, protein filled breakfast on the morning of the test.
5. Try to include extra time the morning of the test to avoid the "morning rush" and start the day off in a calm manner.

BE SURE TO ARRIVE AT SCHOOL ON TIME EACH DAY OF TESTING TO AVOID LAST MINUTE STRESS

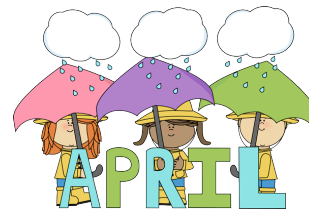
OM UPDATE: ONE SCHRADER TEAM MOVES ON!!!

Welcome new Schrader Raiders! County-wide kindergarten registration is coming up soon!

If you have children who will be five years old on or before September 1, 2015, you should register them on May 4th from 8:30 AM - 2:00 PM. Please bring proof of residency (a recent bill mailed to your home or a lease/mortgage agreement), a Florida immunization card, a current physical less than one year old, a social security card for the child, and an original birth certificate. If you have applied for school choice and you have not heard from District as to whether or not you have been approved by the time of registration, you must register at the school for which you are zoned.
