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FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH TO SIGN UP FOR SCHOOL CHOICE !!!

A letter was sent home at the end of January explaining our School Choice option and the criteria (new to Schrader and not in our zone; out of county - must be filled out every year; 2015-16 kindergarten students not in our zone; currently here on school choice but moved during the year and were only approved until the end of 2014-15.) No forms will be accepted prior to February 1st and all forms must be done online. Please go to the website for the district and there is a link to school choice. http://ses.pasco.k12.fl.us OR http://www.pasco.k12.fl.us. If you are at Schrader on School Choice now and HAVE NOT MOVED OR DO NOT PLAN TO MOVE you do not need to fill out another application. Completion of a form DOES NOT mean an automatic entry. You will be notified by email if you have a computer or by mail if you do not regarding your approval status. Any requests filled out after the February deadline will be put on a waiting list so it is imperative that if school choice is your option, you do so during the month of February. If you have neighbors, relatives, or friends not in this school who may want to attend out of zone, please let them know of this process. Call the school if you have auestions. Thank you.

STEM (Science) FAIR INFORMATION


Hello Students and Schrader Families,

I hope you are having a good time working on your STEM project! If you have questions, please let me know and be sure to check with your teacher for when the completed project is due.

Remember, it is important to test your experiment at least three times, carefully record and graph your data, and complete the STEM booklet to have the best chance of winning and receiving a good grade.

The school fair will be on **Friday, February 20th.** Each teacher in third, fourth, and fifth grade will choose three winners from his or her classroom. The first, second, and third place winners will present their projects at the school STEM Fair and have a chance to win a place at the District STEM Fair. Eight students from Schrader Elementary will have the opportunity to go to the district fair.

Also, I am looking for volunteers to judge the school STEM fair projects. We will have a short training for parents or middle and high school students that would be able to come to the STEM Fair on February 20th and be a STEM Fair judge.
