Welcome new Schrader Raiders! County-wide kindergarten registration is coming up soon!

If you have children who will be five years old on or before September 1, 2016, you should register them on May 4th from 8:30 AM - 2:00 PM. Please bring proof of residency (a recent bill mailed to your home or a lease/ mortgage agreement), a Florida immunization card, a current physical less than one year old, a social security card for the child, and an original birth certificate. If you have applied for school choice and you have not heard from District as to whether or not you have been approved by the time of registration, you must register at the school for which you are zoned.

Call 774-5900 if you need additional information.

(If you cannot make it during district-scheduled county-wide registration, you can register over the summer Monday-Thursday from 9:00-3:00.)
